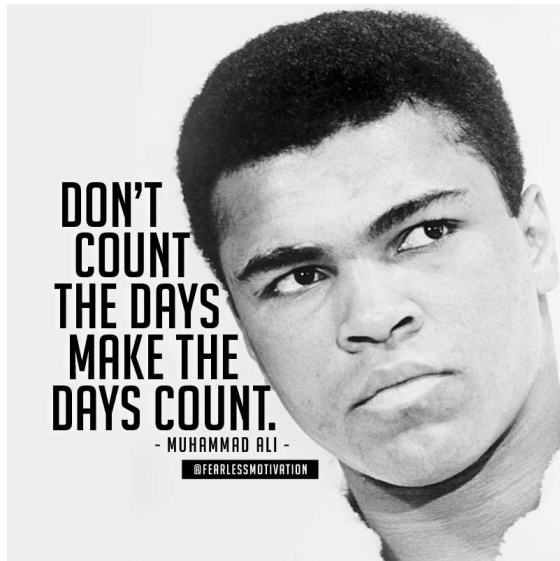


Muhammad Ali Rap
